LIVE PATIENT SURGICAL EXTERNSHIP

In this 6-day comprehensive live patient program, doctors will learn CBCT planning & surgical anatomy, prosthetic-driven surgical planning, flap design, suturing, atraumatic extraction techniques, socket grafting and simple ridge augmentation, crestal sinus lift techniques, and postoperative management. Doctors will also engage in 4 hours of treatment planning each morning.

Participants will operate and assist across multiple cases per day, rotating roles to maximize their surgical exposure and learning under the guidance of world-class faculty.
